Sandra Marshall is a Professor Emeritus in Philosophy at the University of Stirling, Scotland. Her main research interests are in issues that connect legal, political, and social philosophy, especially those arising from debates between liberal and communitarian theories. Her most recent work has been on theories of criminalization, on the idea of public wrongs and the criminal law, and on victims' duties and civic virtue. She was one of four collaborators on The Trial on Trial project, funded by the UK Arts and Humanities Research Council, which produced two edited volumes and a co-authored monograph, and on the Criminalization project, also funded by the Arts and Humanities Research Council, which has so far produced four edited volumes, all published by Oxford University Press.
