How to apply:

- 2) Send a zip folder via WeTransfer including:Project/photo of projectBrief description of the project (Max 200 words)Short bio

All projects submitted must follow these specific formats:

• For image/advertisement/photo/drawing/painting:

Size: maximum A1 Resolution: 300dpi


• For video/animation/illustration:

Format: Mp4

Length: maximum 3 minutes

- For story/poem/creative writing: Maximum length of 1 page (A4): Double spaced; normal margins; font 12
- For prototype/model: Size: maximum of 1x1x1m

Important: upload a photo of the project along with the visualization (drawing, graphic etc.) of the prototype in A3 format. If your project is selected for the exhibition you will have the chance to share it with the world at the Summit. Make sure that the size of your project is compatible with these requests.
