EATING HABITS AND BEHAVIOR OF OUR MEDICAL SCIENCE UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

Non-communicable diseases (NCDs) represent a growing burden globally, posing significant challenges in both high-income and low- and middle-income countries. In particular, certain lifestyle risk factors such as physical inactivity, smoking habit, sleep deprivation and unhealthy diet could expose people to an increased risk of developing NCDs. However, at the same time, societies are paying great attention to the individual responsibility for health ("new health consciousness"), called "healthism", assuming that health can be accomplished in an unproblematic way through individual discipline and moral conduct, mainly through regular exercise and healthy eating. Consequently, an excessive concern with diet and health is growing and is contributing to the development of a persistent fixation about healthy eating, named orthorexia nervosa (ON). According to recent studies, orthorexic behavior is very common among young adults and health professionals.
