

Prof. **Benno Werlen** holds degrees from the natural sciences faculty and the humanities faculty. In addition to geography he studied ethnology, sociology and economics. Since 2018 he holds the UNESCO chair on 'Global Understanding for Sustainability' at the Friedrich Schiller University Jena (Germany). He has held the Chair for Social Geography at the Friedrich Schiller University Jena, from 1997 to 2018, and has taught at the universities of Fribourg (Switzerland), Kiel (Germany), Zurich (Switzerland), ETH Zurich (Switzerland), Cambridge (GB), Salzburg (Austria), Geneva (Switzerland), Nijmegen (the Netherlands), and has been a visiting scholar at the University of Cambridge (Kings College & Sidney Sussex College), the London School of Economics and the University of California, The University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA). Werlen is counted as one of the 'Key Thinkers of Space and Place' (Sage Publisher, 2011), is one of the internationally most cited social geographers and was honored by the International Geographical Union with the Lauréat d'honneur for his 'lifelong contributions to geographical science as a distinguished, world known scholar'.
