The Privatisation of the Public Brazilian Health System

Brazil has one of the world's largest public health systems. More than three quarters of the population rely solely on this system. The universal access to health is the result of organised efforts led by the Sanitary Reform Movement. We will present results showing how this public and free health network of services is being silently privatised by means of transferring its responsibilities to private organisations (the so-called "Social Organisations"), and by hiring private services with public health resources.
